Launched Shared Voices Language Services Social Enterprise



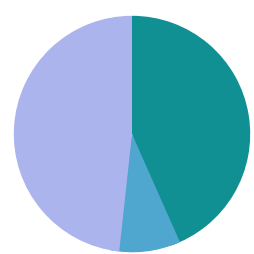
Moved Open Arms Studio to larger location
